Prerequisite for participation:

- Basic knowledge of the mother tongue.

- Basic knowledge of reading and writing. Literacy.

Target group:

Adults with lack of basic training or education gaps in risk of social exclusion: immigrants, premature school leavers, women's collectives, adults over 55, former young offenders, low-qualified workers etc.

Knowledge to acquire:

- Solid knowledge of the basic vocabulary, functional grammar and style as well as the functions of the language.
- Awareness of the main types of verbal interaction (conversations, interviews, debates, etc) and the basic features of the styles and registers of language.
- Comprehension of the paralinguistic features of the communication (voice features, facial expressions, gesture and positions systems.







- Knowledge of different literary texts (short stories, legends, poetry, novels, etc.) and the main characteristics as well as the non literary texts (Curriculum Vitae, templates, reports, editorial articles, speeches etc) and their main characteristics.
- Comprehension of the written language features (formal, informal, scientific, journalistic, colloquial, etc.)
- Awareness of the variability of the language and types of language as well as the communications ways over time and different geographic, social and communicative sceneries.

Skills:

- Skill to communicate both orally and in writing, and to understand or facilitate the understanding of different messages in a variety of contexts and with different purposes.
- Skill to read and understand different texts by adopting adequate strategies as a function of the objective of the Redding and type of text.
- Skill to write different types of texts with different purposes.
- Skill to search, collect and process written information, data and Concepts and for organizing knowledge in a systematic way.
- Skill to formulate and Express one's oral and written arguments in a convincing way bearing in mind other points of view.
- Skills required to use the resources (notes, schemes, maps) necessary to produce, present and understand complex texts in oral and written way (speeches, conversations, instructions, interviews, debates).

Attitudes:

- Development of a positive attitude to the mother tongue through its recognition as potential resource of personal and cultural enrichment.
- Disposition to receive opinions and arguments from others without prejudices and to be able of keeping a critic and constructive dialog.
- Confidence on public speaking.
- Disposition to make effort for reaching aesthetic qualities in the expression beyond the technical correction of a word/sentence.
- Development of the liking for the literature.









- Development of a positive attitude towards the intercultural Communications.
